

# Rosie's Art Sessions- Build a Board Game

## Things you will need

- Large paper or white cardboard white cardboard. If white cardboard is not available use brown cardboard
- Black fine liners pens, coloured pencils, colour pens
- Ruler
- Dice, cup and markers
- Clay, stones and paint for markers

## Steps to follow

1. Think of different things that change how you move. Slides, hot air balloons, trampolines, planes, slippery surfaces, escalators, skateboards, tunnels etc. Decide on a way to move in your game.
2. Draw images that link to your chosen mode of moving and the theme for your board.
3. Design how numbers will be placed on the board. Perhaps in a line, circle, square or another shape altogether.
4. If your using brown cardboard draw the numbers in black pen. Then draw your images separately on white paper then cut them out and collage onto the board.
5. Be playful how numbers and images link in the game and decide on consequences. For example, if the board is a skateboard park you could draw a skater flipping to a higher number or slipping back to a lower number. Our if your moving in a hot air balloon the weather could change which way you move.
6. Use a dice to move around the board
7. Make markers for your game linked to the theme. Small stones can be painted, or clay shaped into different forms.
8. Decide on a name for the game

## Taking it further

1. Design a cover for a box to hold the game,
2. Write the rules for the game in a pamphlet
