

# Rosie's Art Sessions- Draw a Story

- Things you will need
- Paper
- Black pen
- Colour pencils or soft pastels

## Steps to follow

1. Recall skylines you have seen, perhaps mountain ranges, hills or tall buildings in cities. The horizon on the water or flat paddocks with an occasional tree. Look outside and notice where the sky meets the land where you are,
2. A black pen is best to get your ideas down before adding colour.
3. Draw a horizontal line across your paper depicting a skyline of your choice or if it is an imaginary place a line can tell its own story.
4. Decide on a character, it might be you, or an animal or someone from another world
5. Draw the character and imagine what is about to happen. The character might like to explore the space and take a walk along a path. What or who might they see on the way? If it is a hot day, perhaps they need a hat or trees for shade or if it is raining an umbrella or shelter.
6. Are other people or creatures in this place?
7. Is there is a river? A bridge might be useful or a boat.
8. Let the story flow and build.

## Take it further

1. Tell the story using the drawing as a guide. The story and interpretation of the story can change depending on the whim of the artist.
